Call for IEEE TNSE Best Paper Award Nomination:

The IEEE Transactions on Network Science and Engineering (TNSE) is committed to timely publishing of peer-reviewed technical articles that deal with the theory and applications of network science and the interconnections among the elements in a system that form a network. Since 2014, it has published a number of articles on the understanding, prediction, and control of structures and behaviors of networks at the fundamental level.

We are now accepting nominations for the TNSE Best Paper Award. This is the first Best Paper Award in the 5-year history of TNSE, and all the papers published from 2014 to 2017 are eligible for the nomination. A PDF-format nomination letter should be emailed to the TNSE Best Paper Award Committee Chairs, Prof. Jiangchuan Liu (jcliu@cs.sfu.ca) and Prof. My Thai (mythai@cise.ufl.edu), with a copy to Editor in Chief, Prof. Dapeng Oliver Wu (dpwu@ieee.org). The letter should include a full citation of the paper to be nominated and justification for the nomination. Self-nomination is allowed.

The nomination deadline is December 10, 2018 (firm deadline). Decisions will be made by December 31, 2018.
